











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



Feedback Analysis & Action Taken / 2019 - 2020

The newness of the Outcome-based Syllabus	There is a slight ray of dissatisfaction among the students about the newness of the Outcome-based syllabus. Most of them feel the syllabus taught to them is good and excellent.	The institution has taken efforts to display the PSOs, POs, and the COs in the view of the students, so that the value of the Outcome-based education can be understood fully by them.
Learning outcomes of the Programme (in terms of skills, concepts, knowledge, analytical abilities, or broadening perspectives)	Nearly 20% of the learners opine that the learning outcomes have not yet been reached fully by them.	More Internship Training Programmes, Hands-on-training Programmes and Field Visits have been planned to improve the level of attainment of learning outcomes.
The adequacy and relevancy of the syllabus	When all the other students are satisfied with the adequacy and relevancy of the syllabus, 6.1% of the students feel that the syllabus is inadequate.	The institution takes the 6.1% of respondents to be the gifted learners. So, in the next process of framing of the syllabus, suggestion for introducing more innovative courses will be given by the teachers of thi institution in the Board of Studies meeting, conducted by the Mother Teresa Women's University.
Depth of the course content (syllabus)	Nearly 7% of the learners feel the five units in the course content does not hold enough	The course content will be enriched still more by proper representation in the Board of Studies.

The compatibility between your background and the Programme	Comparing the other criterion, the percentage of respondents who feel the coordination between their background and the Programme they learn is less.	As students hail from rural background and have their schooling in regional language, the incompatibility is high. More Spoken English and Communicative English Courses will be given.
The coverage of the syllabus by the teachers	Very less percentage of the students is of the opinion that the syllabus covering work done by the teachers is not satisfactory.	The work done register maintained by the teachers will be verified by the Head of the Department.
The library holdings for the courses	There is a common notion that that the resources available in the college library for the courses is not enough.	It is planned to enrich the number of books and subscription for e-resources.
The internal and external evaluation system of the college	The learners are satisfied with the evaluation system followed by the faculty.	The faculty are advised to keep up still more transparency in discussing the marks scored by the students in the class.
